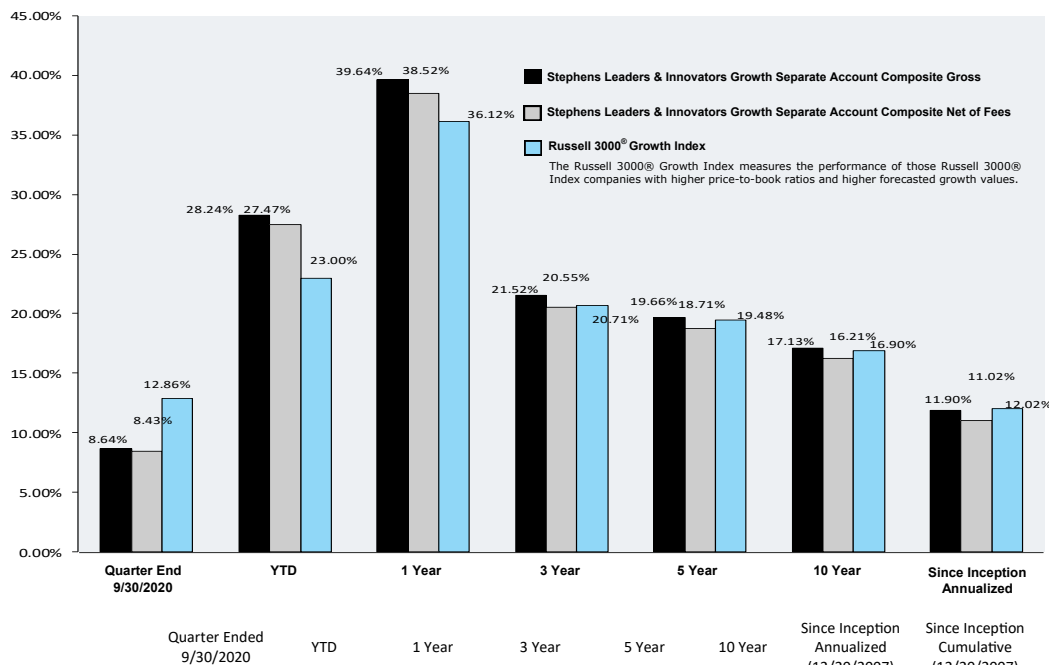

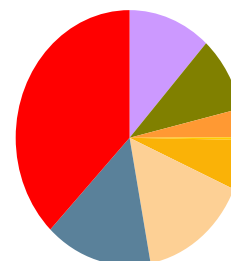

Contains fully discretionary accounts invested in core growth stocks and earnings catalyst stocks which are viewed as having: unique business models that lend themselves to predictable and stable returns; or companies benefiting from meaningful economic leverage to a confirmed theme or trend that is open-ended in nature oftentimes not fully recognized by market participants. The portfolio is comprised largely of equity securities of US issuers but can contain investments in a significant number of non-US issuers and non-equity investments. For comparison purposes the composite is measured against the Russell 3000® Growth Index.

**Stephens Investment Management Group, LLC claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards.
