Studio North is a seven-day intensive building workshop. The workshop offers students the opportunity to engage with the environment and to imagine, develop and construct inventive design solutions. An architectural education is best experienced through engagement in all aspects of the building process. This workshop is a fully immersive design experience.

Program

The workshop this year will take place in Vermont. The workshop will investigate a particular interest and responds with the design and construction of a complete prototype structure. The workshop is limited to ten participants and led by architect **Kyle Neuman** and **Jon Fenton**. **Keith Moskow FAIA** and **Robert Linn AIA** of the Cambridge based firm, Moskow Linn Architects who established the program in 2011 will serve as advisors.

- Lunch each day, dinner on June 1 and celebration dinner on June 8.

Participant's responsibilities:

- Transportation to and from project site (we will assist in organizing carpools).
- Accommodations (students have historically stayed at local hostels).
- Breakfast and dinner – dinners are often group affairs at local restaurants.
- Health insurance.
- Disclosure of any allergies or medical/physical conditions that may influence or limit your participation in Studio North activities, which includes substantial time outdoors.
- Appropriate attire for design/build activities and for a variety of weather conditions.
